

In-Person worship will inevitably lead to a Covid positive situation. We do everything we can to limit risk, but one of two things will eventually happen - a person who has direct exposure to a Covid positive individual will attend worship OR a Covid positive individual will themselves attend worship. Here is what we will do in the event of either:

1. Direct contact with Covid positive individual - we will ask that person to refrain from in-person worship for two weeks.
2. Covid positive individual attends worship - we will inform everyone who was also in that worship and advise them to social distance and monitor themselves for symptoms.

We do not intend to shut down in-person worship for all people in either of these situations. However, this protocol could change if a situation worsens or we are given different guidelines from health officials.

1. Report directly to your area of service and restrict your movement to that area (for example, if you are ushering - stay in the narthex & sanctuary, if you are in the sound booth - stay in the sound booth, etc.)
2. Wear a mask at all times.
3. As parishioners are asked to leave the church after worship, the same holds true for volunteers. Please do not stay inside the church after worship, socializing may take place outside.
4. Because you are in service early, the temptation to socialize among the pews will be great. Please resist this temptation.

These are hard things to ask of volunteers, it can seem harsh and ungrateful, but nothing could be further from the truth! We are so grateful for you and ask out of love - for your safety and that of your neighbor.
